

Cultural Agency and Limits conference: Important information

During the conference

The conference has a full-day schedule both days. We will begin at 9:00. Elizabeth and Andrea will be waiting outside the Sala de Graus with programmes and other materials, such as name badges. On 25 June, we will finish at 19:00 and then go, after a brief break, to the conference dinner. On 26 June, we will finish at 18:00.

There will be various breaks throughout the day between sessions to have a coffee close to the conference room. Lunch will be at 14:30 on Wednesday 25 June and at 14:15 on Thursday 25 June. All participants are invited to lunch. There will be vegan and vegetarian options available.

In order to ensure that we keep to schedule and that there is enough time for discussion after all speakers have presented, we remind you that it is important to honour the time limit allocated to each presentation. Each speaker will have 15 minutes to present, which will be followed by a 45-minute group discussion. If you have a PowerPoint presentation, we ask that you either bring a pen drive to be able to connect to the conference room computer or that you send the presentation via the MoB email address the day before you are scheduled to speak.

Conference dinner (25 June 2025)

All conference participants are invited to attend the conference dinner in [UMAMI](#) restaurant in Bellaterra. The dinner will begin around 20:30 (although we are awaiting confirmation from the restaurant re the exact time). It is possible to walk to the restaurant from the UAB campus.

From the EXE Campus hotel in Bellaterra, it is a 10-minute walk; from the [Facultat de Filosofia i Lletres](#), it is a half-hour walk through the beautiful campus woods. The dinner will have a fixed menu, which will include vegetarian and vegan options.

How to get to UAB

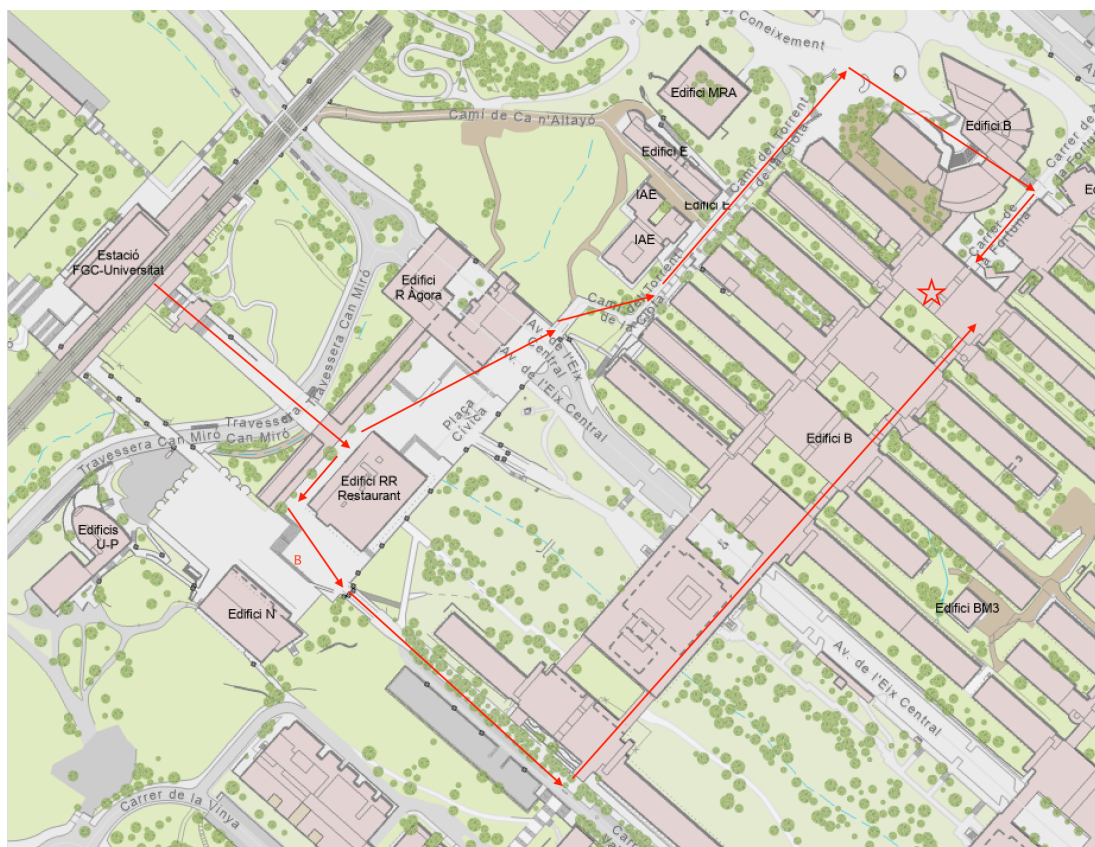

How to get to the conference room from “Universitat Autònoma”

If you are travelling from **Barcelona** via the FGC train, alight at “Universitat Autònoma” station. From there, walk towards the “Facultat de Lletres i Psicologia.” If you enter from the faculty’s main entrance, the Sala de Graus is directly in front on the left. Alternatively, you can enter via the “Facultat de Dret” and walk up through the building until you arrive at the “Facultat de Lletres i Psicologia.” See the map below for both possible routes.

How to get to the Sala de Graus from Hotel EXE (UAB campus hotel)

The walk from the hotel to the Sala de Graus is around 15 minutes (from A to B on the following map). How to get to the Bellaterra campus from the airport

From Josep Tarradellas Barcelona - El Prat airport

Quickest route via public transport (every 12 minutes): Costs approx. 15-20€ and takes around 90 minutes.

1. Take the AEROBUS (A1 if arriving at Terminal 1 or A2 if arriving at Terminal 2) to Plaça Catalunya. A single costs 7.45 €, whereas a return is 12.85 €.
2. Alight at Plaça Catalunya and walk through the square towards Bar Zurich. Just in front of the bar is the FGC (Ferrocarriles de la Generalitat) station entrance. A single-zone ticket cost 3.80 €.

*Please note that the FBC is different to the METRO and RENFE (look for the entrance with

this symbol: )

3. Once in the FGC station, take the S2 train towards Sabadell Parc del Nord.
If you are going to the Exe Campus Bellaterra hotel, alight at “Bellaterra” station.
If you are going directly to the conference room, alight at “Universitat Autònoma” station.

Cheaper but less-frequent option (every 30 minutes). Costs approx. 5-7€ and also takes around 90 minutes

1. In terminal 2, take the RENFE train – Rosalies R2 line – towards Sant Celoni. Alight at Sants station. Please note that if you arrive in Terminal 1, you will have to take a shuttle to Terminal 2 in order to get to the RENFE station).
2. Once in Sants, take one of the Rodalies trains (R1, R3, or R4) and alight at the next station, which is Plaza Catalunya.
3. Once on the main street, walk through the square towards Bar Zurich. Just in front of the bar is the FGC (Ferrocarriles de la Generalitat) station entrance. A single-zone ticket cost 2.65 €. Please note that there is also the option of a T-casual ticket that offers 10 journeys (valid for the train, bus, metro, and tram) for 12.55 €.

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Quickest but most expensive option

- Taxi (costs around 60 € and takes 35 minutes)
- Uber (Price varies due to demand. Also takes 35 minutes. Must reserve via the app)
