



Condiciones de trabajo y salud tras un año de COVID-19 (COTS2)

Working conditions and health after one year of COVID-19 (COTS2)

COTS2 is an online epidemiological survey conducted 26 April–24 May 2021 among salaried workers residing in Spain who were employed on 14 March 2020 (the date Spain declared the state of alarm). The final sample comprised $n=25,100$ participants. Compared with the [first COTS wave \(2020\)](#), COTS2 shows substantial improvements in the use of COVID-19 protective measures; however, harmful exposures such as job insecurity and high job strain remained widespread, and salaried workers' health continued to deteriorate. Inequalities by social class, gender and age persisted—and in some cases widened. The project was carried out jointly with [ISTAS-CCOO](#).
